All Written Submissions which follow the submission guidelines below will be published.

GEP 2023 Theme

"Science and Faith"

Detail

Written Submissions outline a Member of Parliament's research on the focal theme, "Science and Faith."

The Written Submission should include the Member of Parliament's recommendations for what the Parliament ought to adopt in terms of a resolution, recommendation or policy suggestion to governments on the focal theme.

The questions for GEP 2023 are:

- What is the role of science in the problems that your portfolio / field of work tries addresses?
- What is the role of faith in solving those problems?
- Are there common elements they share?
- How can they be used to help humanity attain its highest goals of peace, harmony, balance and sustainability?
- What do governments need to do, and what do citizens need to do?

Members of Parliament are encouraged to stay within their own area of expertise. Every area has a relevance in the Global Energy Parliament. The major areas are divided into Portfolios, namely: Administration, Agriculture, Child Welfare, Communications, Commerce & Industry, Culture, Education, Environment, Finance & Economy, Health, Housing, Human Resources, Law & Justice, Natural Resources, Science and Technology, Peace & Global Affairs, Parliamentary Affairs, Power, Social Welfare, Sports, and Youth Affairs.



Format

The length of Written Submissions is to be 4-8 typed pages with References.

12-pt font, 1.5 spaced pages.

The name of the Member of Parliament, contact address and phone number should be marked clearly on the top of the first page.

References should follow APA style. (https://apastyle.apa.org).

Final Papers must be in Microsoft Word format.

We do not encourage authors to use any prior published material. The author should disclose any prior distribution and/or publication of any portion of the material, including where the manuscript has been shared, and ensure that appropriate attribution to the prior distribution and/or publication of the material is included.

Authors are responsible for obtaining permission from copyright holders for reproducing any illustrations, tables, figures or lengthy quotations previously published elsewhere.

Eligibility
